



LA RICOTTA SUMMER SCHOOL PROPOSAL

LA RICOTTA SUMMER SCHOOLS are structured to run over a period of two weeks, with two courses per week, each complemented by tutorials. Each course has a total duration of 7.5 hours, divided into 5 lectures of 1.5 hours each. The tutorials have a total duration of 5 hours per course, divided into two sessions of 2.5 hours each, with an additional session of 2.5 hours on Friday. This session can be either a shared tutorial between the two lecturers during the same week, or reserved for independent work. The maximum number of participant is 25.

LA RICOTTA SUMMER SCHOOLS are committed to having a cultural impact on the area where the venue is located. For this reason, at least one of the organisers or lecturers is required to be Spanish speaker – that is, fluent enough in Spanish to deliver a public lecture, though not necessarily a native speaker. Furthermore, if there are Spanish-speaking participants, they should be involved in public events. Public events may include outreach seminars on topics related either to the proposed school or to socio-scientific issues – that is topics of social relevance with scientific content –, experiments, hands-on activities, and similar engagements.
